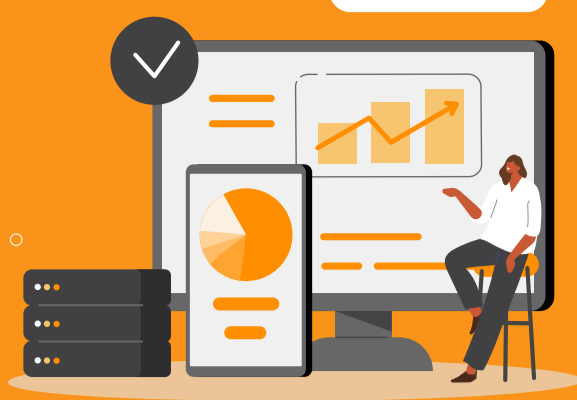
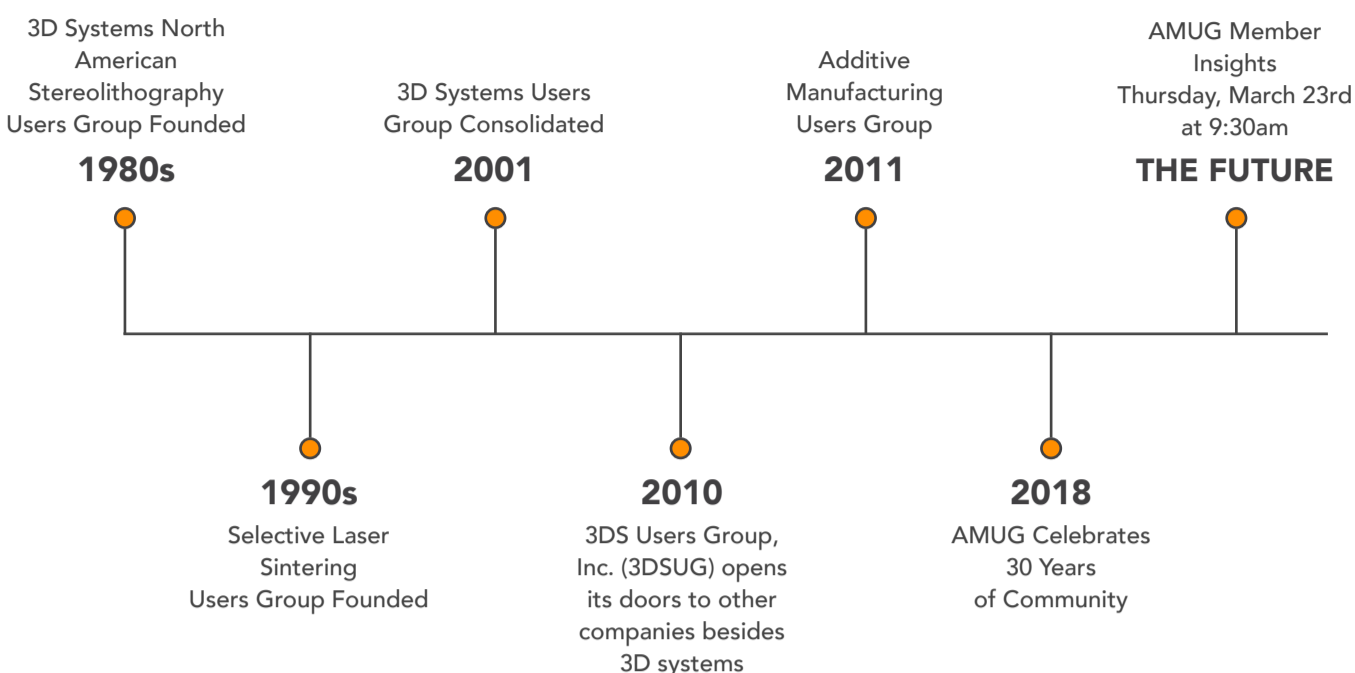

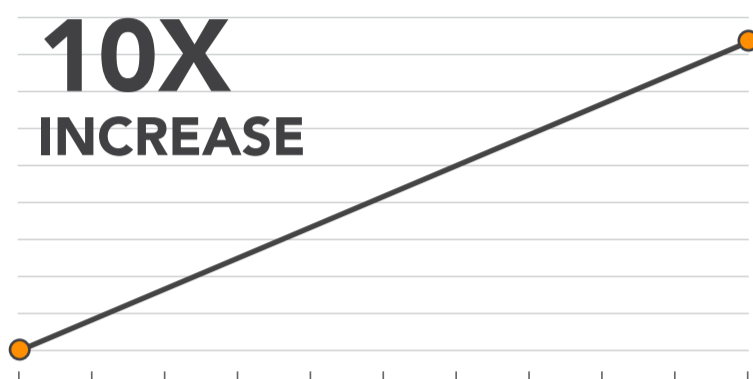

## History of AMUG



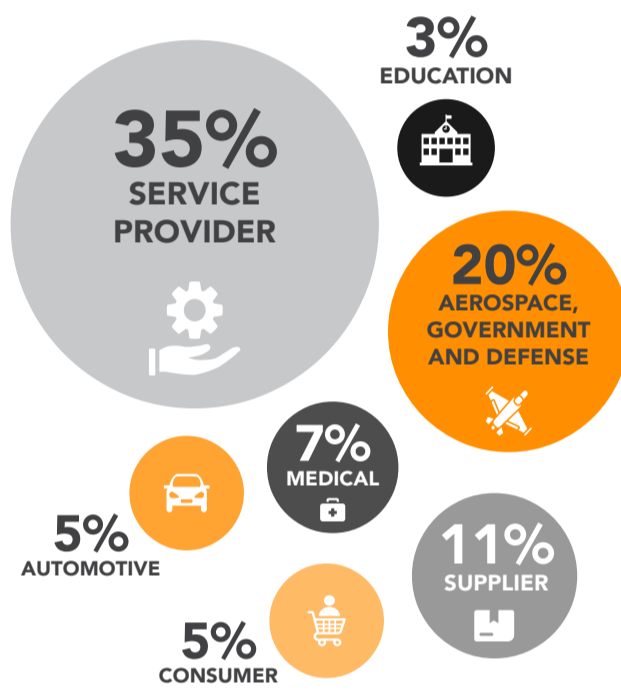

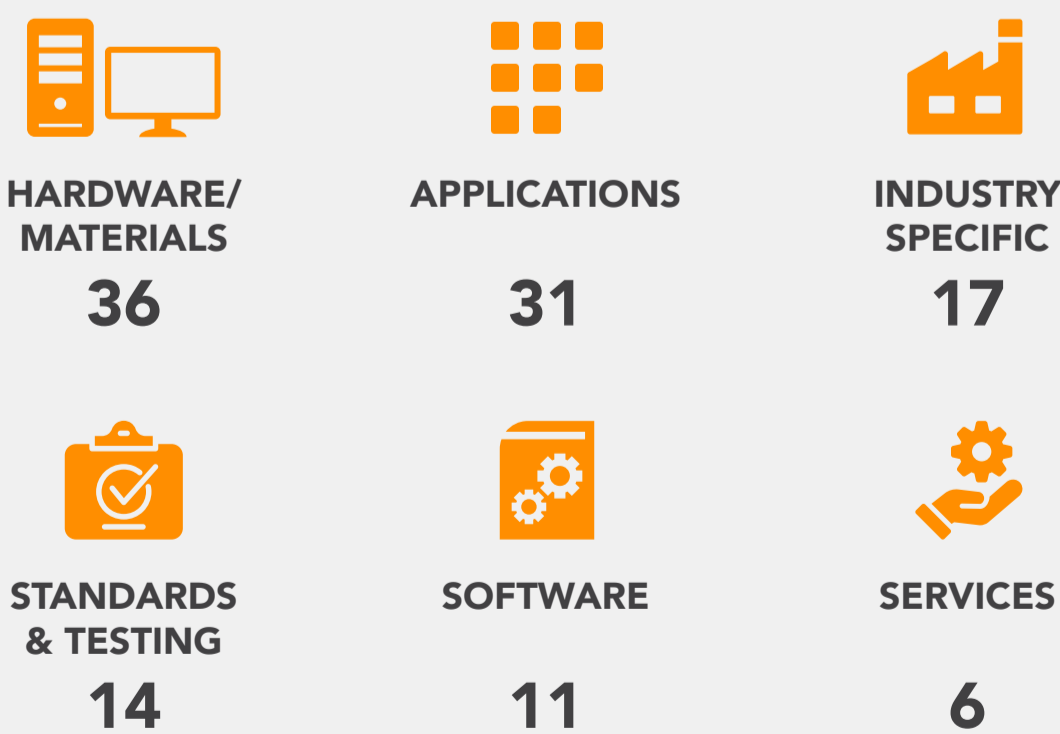

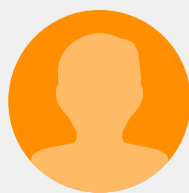

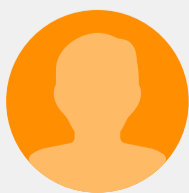
